MUNICIPAL ACT, 2001 CHANGES WITH RESPECT TO TAX ARREARS
 The Province of Ontario has changed the legislation with regard to registration of a tax arrears certificate. A tax arrears certificate may be registered on property where taxes are in arrears on January 1 in the second year following that in which the taxes became owing. Previously, registration was allowed in the third year of arrears. You are urged to clear up any outstanding property taxes from 2016 by the end of March 2018, to avoid tax sale proceedings against your property. Any outstanding taxes from 2017 will need to be paid in full by the end of 2018 to avoid tax sale proceedings on January 1, 2019. Please contact the municipal office to make suitable payment arrangements.

Massey Water Bylaw: Lawn & Garden Care
 Even street numbers on even numbered days; odd street numbers on odd numbered days from 7am to 10am and 7pm to 10pm. Additional watering information available at the Township office and the complete bylaw is on our website. Any person, occupant or owner of a property who contravenes the provision of this by-law shall be subject to the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.

REDUCED LOAD PERIOD SHALL START ON THE 1ST OF MARCH AND IS IN EFFECT WHILE THE APPROPRIATE SIGNAGE IS ERECTED.

EMERGENCY SERVICES for all emergencies–CALL 9-1-1
 Callers on a Four-party line dialing 911 will be routed to a Bell Operator, and must identify the emergency location. If there is a disruption in telephone services when calls cannot be completed to other exchanges:

1. Residents in 844 exchange should call 844-2100 or 844-2047
2. Residents in 865 exchange should call 865-2073
3. Residents in 869 exchange should call 869-3111

Post Your Number
 We can't help you if we can't find you. Seconds can mean the difference between life and death in an emergency. Getting resources where they are needed as quickly as possible is vital. This is especially true when dealing with 911 emergencies. However, without clearly posted civic numbers to guide them, emergency responders can sometimes have difficulty locating the address of a 911 emergency.

Make sure that your civic number is posted in front of your home or business, and that it is clearly visible from the road day or night. This will assist police, firefighters and paramedics in being able to locate you as quickly as possible if an emergency should occur.
