BYLAW NUMBER 2021 - <u>17</u>

Being a Bylaw to Amend the Bylaw to Designate the Date and Locations on Which a Reduced Load Period Shall Start and End

WHEREAS Subsection 7 of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.H8, as amended provides that: The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by bylaw designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of highways in the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers;

AND WHEREAS Bylaw 2013-22 of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers was enacted to apply a reduced load period on municipal roads from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March to the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June inclusive in each and every year;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers has deemed it appropriate to remove this restriction for a specific circumstance on a specific route;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Section 1 of Bylaw 2013-22 is hereby amended to remove the reduced load period on that portion of Lee Valley Road from Massey, Lacloche Lake Road, Brohart Road, Hammond Road and Mooney Road, in order to access #155 Mooney Road for a circumstance of an emergency nature;
- 2. This Bylaw shall amend Bylaw 2013-22 for the year 2021 only and only as required to provide access to resolve the existing emergency circumstance.

# 2021 Draft Capital Budget Revisions

At the March 10th, 2021 Council meeting the Lee Valley/Crossover Bridge project was discussed and the Treasurer was directed to once again include it in the 2021 Draft Capital Budget. Taking into consideration the financial impact this would have on the municipality, the Treasurer advised the Committee that even with the 3% tax increase, utilizing all of our OCIF funding (\$101,396) and available FGT funds (approx. \$440,657) there would still be a need to debenture a large portion of the cost of the project. After much more discussion and deliberation, the Finance Committee decided to defer the bridge project for one year and make the following recommendations to Council:

- 1. Remove Lee Valley/Burns Crossover Bridge (\$750,000) from the 2021 Capital Budget and make this project a priority in the 2022 Capital Budget.
- 2. Remove the \$55,000 for Lee Valley road work and defer to 2022 inconsideration of the additional traffic flow expected in 2021. Regular maintenance will continue as per the 2021 operating budget.
- 3. Give staff direction to request the Engineer to proceed with the preliminary work required for the Massey Storm Sewer Repairs project and the Old Webbwood Road Culvert Replacement project to be included in the 2021 Capital Budget.

### Council Budget

The Treasurer requested confirmation of whether or not Council would receive the 2% increase granted to permanent municipal employees effective January 1, 2021.

Finance Committee recommends that Council receive the 2% increase for 2021 and going forward that the increase will be decided upon at the same time as the permanent municipal employees.

## Transfer of COVID-19 SRA Funds for 2020

The Treasurer provided the Finance Committee with a staff report outlining the recommended transfer of COVID-19 Safe Restart Agreement funds to adjust for our lost revenues in 2020. The Finance Committee had no concerns and recommends that Council approve the transfer of funds.

### Other

### Tax Policy Decisions

The Finance Committee makes the following recommendations to Council:

- 1. The Treasurer be authorized to prepare the 2021 Budget using a 3% increase over the 2020 tax rates. The Treasurer will compile the budgets as amended into one document for the next Finance meeting.
- 2. That the 2021 tax ratios be the same as the tax ratios for 2020.

### <u>Library</u>

Prior to the Finance meeting the Treasurer received a request from the CEO/Chief Librarian Serena Mariage. The CEO/Chief Librarian is aware that the 2021 budget has not been approved but indicated that the Libraries are in need of a partial release of operating funds within the next couple of months.

The Finance Committee makes the following recommendation to Council: The Libraries receive an amount equal to 50% of last years municipal contribution prior to the 2021 budget approval.

The meeting adjourned at 7:00 pm. Next meeting is April 19th, 2021 at 6:00pm.
