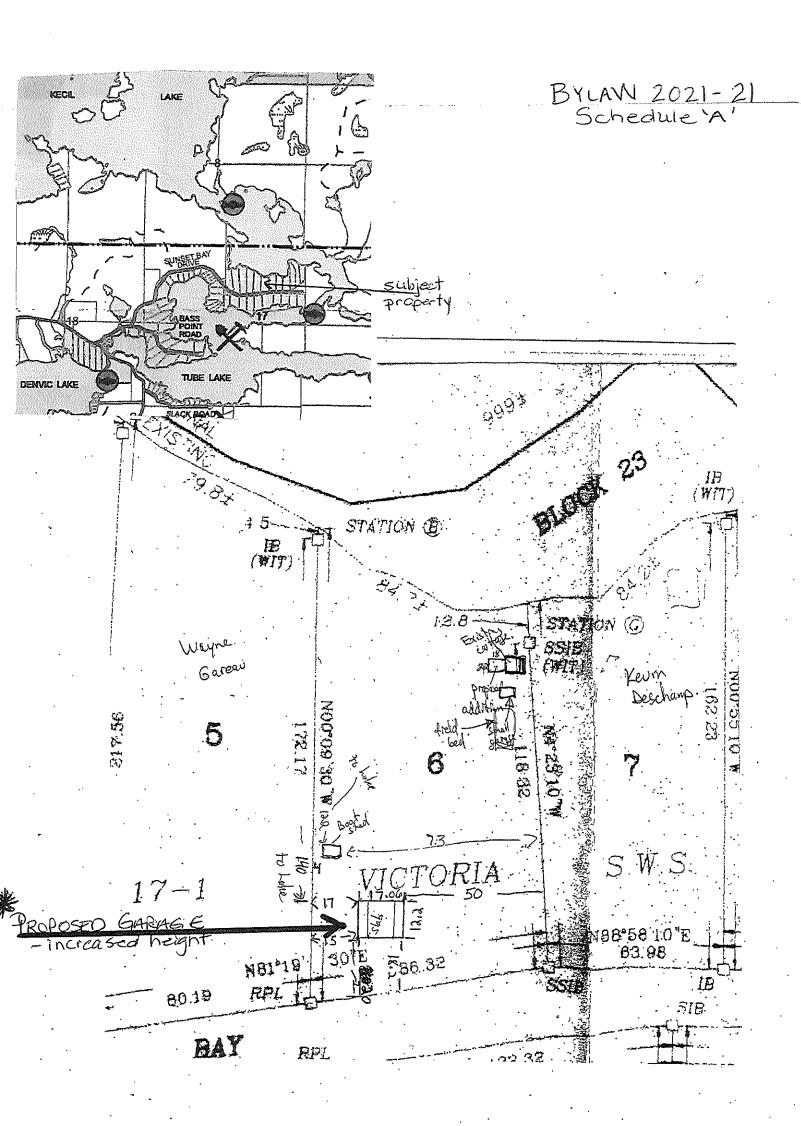

2021 Final Capital Budget

The Finance Committee has agreed to use the OCIF Formula Component as follows:

• Aberdeen Street Paving - \$100,000

The Finance Committee has agreed to use a portion of the available Federal Gas Tax funds as follows:

- Massey Storm Sewer Repairs \$300,000
- Agnew Lake Rd Resurfacing \$30,000 \$50,000

The Treasurer indicated a change to the Massey Arena Structural project, it was increased to \$150,000 with the additional \$50,000 being funded from what was raised in 2020 for the project.

Subsequent to the meeting it was brought to the Treasurer's attention that the Geo-technical component required for the Webbwood Waterline Engineering project had not been included. The project total has been increased to \$36,000 from \$16,000.

Finance Committee recommends that the following resolution be passed by at the next Council meeting: BE IT RESOLVED that Public Works be authorized to participate in group tendering with the Manitoulin & North Shore Roads Supervisors Association for our 2021 Surface Treatment Projects as per the proposed Capital Budget.

2021 Tax Policy Decisions

An Optional Small Business Property Subclass will not be implemented at this time due to lack of information from the Province. When more information becomes available to municipalities the Treasurer will update Council.

Due to the economic situation the pandemic has caused the Finance Committee recommends that the Commercial Vacancy Rebate program remain in place for the time being. This will be reviewed again with the Treasurer and Council in 6 months time.

Other

2021 Canada Summer Jobs – the Township applied for 5 summer student positions and we have received funding approval for 3 of the positions.

The Annual Treasurer's Report will be considered for adoption at the next council meeting.

The Finance Committee recommends that Council give notice at the next regular Council meeting of its intention to adopt the 2021 budget at its meeting of May 12, 2021. A resolution of Council will be prepared to this effect and proper notice will be provided as per the Notice Bylaw.
