### GARBAGE & RECYCLING

**\*\*ATTENTION: RECYCLING MAGNETS WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE 2022 INTERIM TAX BILLS DUE TO A POSSIBLE CHANGE IN THE WASTE DISPOSAL CONTRACT\*\***

**PICKUP FROM RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES IS EVERY THURSDAY; PLEASE HAVE IT AT YOUR CURB BY 6:00 AM.**

\*For residences with seasonal pick-up, pick-up **begins** the 1st Thursday after May long weekend and **ends** the 1st Thursday after Thanksgiving.

**GARBAGE:** Current Bag Limit is 2 bags per residence and 8 bags per commercially assessed property. Each bag shall not exceed 40 lbs in weight.

**RECYCLING:** one week is the collection of fibers (paper & cardboard) and the next week is the collection of commingle (cans, plastic & glass).

Additional bag tags are available for \$2.00 each at the Township office and the Massey and Webbwood libraries.

## BUILDING DEPARTMENT

The Building Inspector (Jeff Lapierre) is in the office on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays (8am-4pm). ## STORAGE CONTAINERS, STORAGE TRAILERS AND SEA-CANS

Storage container means a pre-fabricated metal or steel accessory building used for the transport and/or storage of goods and materials.

The regulations respecting storage containers can be found in our Zoning Bylaw Section 4.32, 4.33 and Table 4.32. If you are unsure if this is a permitted use on your property, please call the office. Also note that where permitted, a storage container requires a Building Permit prior to being placed on the property. All newly installed storage containers will be subject to this requirement, as it will be enforced by the building inspector.

## NOTICE TO MASSEY WATER USERS

In the event of extreme cold weather conditions, we recommend that you leave a cold-water tap running in a steady stream of about 6mm (1/4 inch). Please note that the tap does not need to be fully open to prevent your line from freezing. The water entering the water distribution system is already cold so it takes very little exposure to colder temperatures for the water to freeze. If you are concerned about your septic system, run a hose out to the ditch or catch basin to drain the water away from your system.

Additional Suggestions:

- Wrap foam pipe insulation around pipes most susceptible to freezing (near outside walls, crawl spaces, attics)
- Do not turn your heat below 13°C (55°F) at night or when the house is vacant
- If you are planning on being away, have someone check your house regularly

## PARKING RESTRICTIONS / WINTER SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS

\*No persons shall park a vehicle on any municipal road allowance between the hours of 2a.m. and 8a.m., or during other periods of snowplowing operations, from November 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>, except for emergency and health care vehicles.

\*Any vehicles interfering with snowplowing operations will be ticketed or towed away at the owner's expense.



\*Parking of heavy vehicles (transports) is restricted on any public streets or roads, except when actually engaged in the activity of loading or unloading the vehicle. Heavy vehicle drivers are permitted to use the tractor for travelling to and from their homes, and to park same in private driveways. Parking of the trailers is available in the Township yard, at your own risk.

\*No person shall park a motor vehicle on any highway unless on the right-hand side of the highway having regard to the direction of the flow of traffic.

\*In the event of freezing rain, equipment will not be out until conditions are safe for employees and equipment, however in case of emergency all efforts will be made to assist in reaching the emergency.

\*The removal of snow from private driveways onto the road allowance is prohibited, pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act.

## EMERGENCY SERVICES For all emergencies – call 9-1-1

Callers on a Four-party line dialing 911 will be routed to a Bell Operator, and must identify the emergency location. If there is a disruption in telephone services when calls cannot be completed to other exchanges:

1. Residents in 844 exchange should call 705-844-2100
2. Residents in 865 exchange should call 705-865-2073
3. Residents in 869 exchange should call 705-869-3407
