#### BYLAW NUMBER 2022-01

Being a Bylaw to authorize temporary borrowing from time to time to meet current expenditures during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022

WHEREAS Section 407 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, provides authority for a council by by-law to authorize the head of council or the treasurer or both of them to borrow from time to time, such sums as the council considers necessary to meet, until taxes are collected and other revenues are received, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year; and

WHEREAS the total amount which may be borrowed from all sources at any one time to meet the current expenditures of the Municipality, except with the approval of the Municipal Board, is limited by Section 407 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers enacts as follows:

- The head of council or the treasurer or both of them are hereby authorized to borrow from time to time during the fiscal year (hereinafter referred to as the current year) such sums as may be necessary to meet, until taxes are collected and other revenues are received, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the current year.
- The lender(s) from whom amounts may be borrowed under authority of this by-law shall be **Royal Bank of Canada** and such other lender(s) as may be determined from time to time by by-law of council.
- The total amount which may be borrowed at any one time under this by-law plus any outstanding amounts of principal borrowed and accrued interest under Section 407 together with the total of any similar borrowings that have not been repaid, shall not exceed from January 1 to September 30 of the current year, 50 percent of the total estimated revenues of the Municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the current year, and from October 1 to December 31 of the current year, 25 percent of the total of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set out in the budget adopted for the current year or \$ 500,000.00, whichever is less.
- The treasurer shall, at the time when any amount is borrowed under this by-law, ensure that the lender is or has been furnished with a certified copy of this by-law, (a certified copy of the resolution mentioned in section 2 determining the lender,) if applicable, and a statement showing the nature and amount of the estimated revenues for the current year and also showing the total of any other amounts borrowed from any and all sources under authority of section 407 of the Municipal Act that have not been repaid.
- a) If the budget for the current year has not been adopted at the time an amount is borrowed under this by-law, the statement furnished under section 4 shall show the nature and amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the budget adopted for the previous year and the nature and amount of the revenues received for and on account of the current year.
- b) If the budget for the current year has not been adopted at the time an amount is borrowed under this by-law, the limitation on borrowing set out in section 3 shall be calculated for the time being upon the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the budget adopted for the previous year less all revenues received for and on account of the current year.
- 6 For purposes of this by-law the estimated revenues referred to in section 3, 4, and 5 do not include revenues derivable or derived from, a) any borrowing, including through any issue of debentures; b) a surplus, including arrears of taxes, fees or charges; or c) a transfer from the capital fund, reserve funds or reserves.

- 7. The treasurer be and is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all or, any sums borrowed under this by- law, together with interest thereon, all or any of the moneys hereafter collected or received, either on account of or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and previous years or from any other source, that may be lawfully applied for such purpose.
- 8. Evidences of indebtedness in respect of borrowings made under section 1 shall be signed by the head of the council or conform to the treasurer or both of them.
- 9. The Bank shall not be responsible for establishing the necessity of temporary borrowing under this by-law or the manner in which the borrowing is used.
- 10. This by-law shall take effect on the final day of passing.

### BYLAW NO. 2022-02

Being a Bylaw to provide for an Interim Tax Levy

WHEREAS Section 317 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S. O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that the Council of a local Municipality may, in 2022, before the adoption of the estimates for the current year, pass a by-law to levy on the whole of the assessment for real property according to the last revised assessment roll, a sum not to exceed that which would be produced by applying the prescribed percentage (or 50 percent if no percentage is otherwise prescribed) of the total taxes levied for municipal and school purposes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers enacts as follows:

In this by-law the following words shall be defined as:

"Collector" shall mean the Tax Collector;

"Minister" shall mean the Minister of Finance;

"MPAC" shall mean the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation;

- 1. The amounts levied shall be as follows:
  - 1.1 For the Residential, Pipeline, Farmland and Managed Forest property classes there shall be imposed and collected an interim levy of:
  - a) the percentage prescribed by the Minister under Section 317(10) of the Municipal Act; or,
  - b) 50%, if no percentage is prescribed,

of the total taxes for municipal and school purposes levied in the year 2021.

- 1.2 For the Multi-residential, Commercial and Industrial property classes there shall be imposed and collected in interim levy of:
- c) the percentage prescribed by the Minister under Section 317(10) of the Municipal Act; or,
- d) 50%, if no percentage is prescribed,

of the total taxes for municipal and school purposes levied in the year 2021.

- 2. For the purposes of calculating the total amount of taxes for the year 2021 under paragraph 1, if any taxes for municipal school purposes were levied on a property for only part of 2021 because assessment was added to the collector's roll during 2021, an amount shall be added equal to the additional taxes that would have been levied on the property if taxes for municipal and school purposes had been levied for the entire year.
- 3. The provisions of this by-law apply in the event that assessment is added for the year 2021 to the collector's roll after the date this by-law is passed and an interim levy shall be imposed and collected.
- 4. All taxes levied under this by-law shall be payable into the hands of the Collector at the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers Municipal Office, Massey, Ontario in accordance with the provisions of this by-law.
- 5. The said interim tax levy shall become due and payable on the 28th day of February, 2022.

- 6. On all taxes of the interim levy, which are in default on the 1st day of March a penalty of 1.25 percent per month will be added on the first day of each and every month during which the default continues, until December 31st.
  - (a) On all of the interim tax levy in default on January 1st, 2023, interest will be added at the rate of 1.25 percent per month for each month or fraction thereof of default;
  - (b) On all other taxes in default on January 1st, 2023, interest shall be added at the rate of 1.25 percent per month or fraction thereof, and all by-laws and parts of by-laws inconsistent with this policy are hereby rescinded.
- 7. Penalties and interest added on all taxes of the interim tax levy in default shall become due and payable and shall be collected forthwith as if the same had originally been imposed and formed part of such unpaid interim tax levy.
- 8. The collector may mail or cause the same to be mailed to the residence or place of business of such person indicated on the last revised assessment roll, a written or printed notice specifying the amount of taxes payable.
- 9. The Collector shall be authorized to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due, and to give a receipt of such part payment, provided that acceptance of any such part payment shall not affect the collection of any percentage charge imposed and collectable under Section 5 of this by-law in respect of non-payment or late payment of any taxes or any installment of taxes.
- 10. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.



#### Being a Bylaw to Appoint a Fire Chief

WHEREAS Section 2 of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act 1997 (FPPA) provides that every municipality shall establish a program that must include public education with respect to the fire safety and fire prevention, and to provide such other fire protection services as it determines may be necessary in accordance with its needs and circumstances;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers enacted Bylaw 18-04 to establish and operate the Fire Department pursuant to Section 5 of the FPPA;

AND WHEREAS Section 6 of the FPPA provides that a council of a municipality shall appoint a Fire Chief if a Fire Department has been established;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That BLAIR RAMSAY is hereby appointed as Fire Chief for the Corporation of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers, retroactive to January 7, 2022;
- 2. That Bylaw 2018-19 is hereby repealed.
