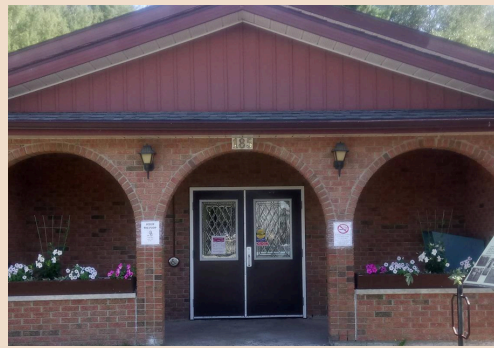

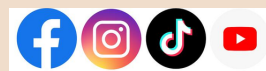

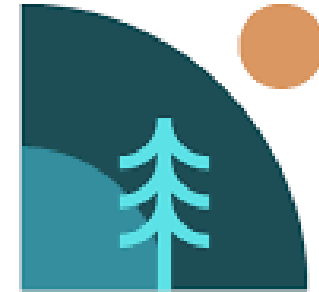

What is the Library Board?

The Sables-Spanish Rivers Public Library Board is the governing body of the Library. The Board follows the Ontario Public Libraries Act, and members are appointed by council.

The Board is responsible for:

- Advocating for the Library
- Developing a strategic plan for the Library
- Creating and revising policies for the Library
- Developing the budget
- Hiring and evaluating the CEO

The Board delegates the responsibility for the daily operations of the Library to the CEO.

What Makes a Great Library Board Member?

Someone Who:

- is passionate about the library
- is enthusiastic about working as a member of a team committed to community service
- is familiar with library services

How Do I Apply?

The Municipal Clerk will give notice of approval and appointment of new members.

Who Can Become a Library Board Member?

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Canadian Citizen or permanent resident of Canada
- Resident of the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers

The SSRPL Board can have up to 10 members, comprising of 2 council members.

Time Commitment:

- 10 Meetings a year, excluding the months of July & August
- Meetings are held the 4th Monday of each month
- Zoom meetings during winter months (January-April)
- Board members serve for 4 years, concurrent with the council term. Board members may resign from their position at any time, by sending a resignation letter to the TSSR or the Library CEO.
